ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR JUDGMENT ON THE PLEADINGS

The defendant State of Tennessee has filed a Motion for Judgment on the Pleadings in this case.

Previously, the defendant has voluntarily dismissed her claim for damages under the tort theory originally alleged in her claim.

Subsequently, on March 3, 2009, a hearing was held regarding claimant's remaining claim alleging breach of contract. At that time, claimant's counsel detailed his extensive efforts to locate a written contract between Hancock County and the State of Tennessee regarding autopsy services to be preformed at the Quillen-Dishner College of Medicine at East Tennessee State University. Claimant's counsel represented that despite his efforts, no written contract was ever located. Accordingly, the Commission dismissed the contract claim set out in this case since claimant could produce no written contract as required by Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 9-8-307(a)(1)(L).

It appears that since both claimant's tort and contract theories, as alleged in her claim, are not viable and that there are no other theories alleged

in that claim, this matter must be **DISMISSED** and therefore the defendant State's Motion for Judgment of the Pleading is **GRANTED**.


