Job Overview:

The Information Systems Division is seeking three SQL Developers/Junior DBAs to support creating new, and enhancing existing software applications. These positions will serve as key members of the development project team.

Key Responsibilities:

- Create Transact SQL scripts to maintain data based on work item requirements created by system users.
- Participate in daily meetings with development team and update progress on work items assigned.
- Confer with manager or project manager on status of work items and provide feedback from system users.
- Collaborate with system users on requirements when needed.
- Estimate level of effort of work items.
- Maintain status of work items in project management tool.
- Review and run SQL scripts in various database environments for software deployment.
- Create and modify stored procedures.
- Monitor database activity to identify expensive queries.
- Optimize SQL code to improve efficiency.

Qualifications:

- Graduation from an accredited four-year college or university with a bachelor's degree in Computer Science or Information Systems is required.
- 3 to 5 years of experience using SQL Server Management Studio 2008 R2 or later.
