To the General Assembly
of the State of Tennessee,

Pursuant to the provisions of the Ninth Section of an Act passed on the Second day of February, 1836, entitled an Act to provide for electing a Treasurer for the State of Tennessee, and to define his duties, I have the honor to report, that the receipts into the Treasury since the first Monday of October, 1841, have been four hundred seventy-three thousand, twenty-two dollars and one cent. . . . \$473,022 01

In the Treasury on said first Monday of October, 1841, one hundred eighty-nine thousand, five hundred and ninety dollars and forty-seven cents. . . . 189,590 47

Making a total of. . . . 662,612 48

Disbursements during the same period, six hundred twenty-three thousand, seven hundred and thirty-seven dollars and twenty-seven cents. . . . 623,737 27

Leaving in the Treasury on the 2d inst. . . . 38,875 21
