# INTRODUCTORY REMARKS

## STATE OF TENNESSEE.

Office of the Treasurer.

Nashville, Tenn., December 19, 1918.

Hon. Tom C. Rye, Governor.

Sir: Pursuant to the Acts of 1873, Chapter 2, Section 2, the Treasurer of the State of Tennessee is charged with the duty of compiling and submitting to your Excellency an exact statement of the balance in the Treasury to the credit of the State, with a summary of the receipts and payments of the Treasury during the two preceding years. Such report has been carefully prepared for the biennial fiscal period, ending December 19, 1918, which I have the honor to transmit herein.

### EMERGENCY FUND.

This fund was created by the Legislature of 1905, which set aside \$75,000 to draw 4 per cent interest and can be disbursed only for repairing the institutions of the State that may be damaged by fire or cyclone, being purely an insurance fund. The tabular statement of this account is as follows:

### UNCLAIMED ASSETS.

The County Court Clerk of Hamilton County notified me in May, 1916, of the estate of John Pierson, deceased, amounting

to \$3,344.76. Upon investigation I found that said estate was unclaimed assets and due to be turned into the State Treasury, under Sections 4015-16, Shannon's Code, as follows:

"After the lapse of seven years from the grant of administration, if any part of the estate remain unclaimed by the kin of the deceased, or by the creditors, it shall be paid by the administrator into the State Treasury, and remain subject to the claims of the next of kin and of creditors, without limitation of time."

"The Treasurer, in all such cases, shall demand payment of such administrator, and, on refusal or delay, shall give him thirty days' notice to appear and show cause why he refuses or delay payment; and on non-appearance may enter judgment and thereon proceed to execution for the purposes aforesaid."

I proceeded under this authority and settlement was made with me. I make the following statement of this account:

### STATE DEPOSITORIES.

The statute provides that the various banks of the State shall file a depository bond, thereby becoming a State depository; that said bond must have the approval of the Comptroller of the State. Under the statute no depository can carry more than one-fourth of its capital stock, and the funds shall be prorated according to the capital stock. I have endeavored to carry out the spirit of the law. The State has received in interest, under this law, during this term \$71,015.06.

When the Knoxville Banking & Trust Company failed in 1912, there was on deposit of the State's funds in that institution \$37,500. Three payments have been made and the amount involved has been reduced to \$18,875.00. Suit is still pending in the courts for the collection of balance, and is in the hands of Hon. Frank M. Thompson, Attorney General. When the failure of the Bank of Finger, of Finger, Tenn., occurred, there was a deposit of \$1,002.50, which has been reduced to \$301.50, which is pending settlement in the courts.

### BUILDING AND LOAN DEPARTMENT.

By virtue of the provisions of Chapter 114, Acts of 1895, the State Treasurer has supervision over all Building and Loan

Associations authorized by law to transact business in Tennessee. In pursuance to the requirements of this law the business operations of all associations have been thoroughly checked and audited and a complete report, including the book value of the stock by series or dates of issue, has been submitted by this department to the Governor at the end of each year.

For the year ended June 30, 1918, there were thirteen Building and Loan Associations authorized by law to transact business in Tennessee, which contributed a State Tax of \$3,881.50, which less \$219.75 expenses of the Department, was turned over to the State Treasurer. There was also a small amount of back taxes collected, which were turned over to the State in full. The Bluff City Building and Loan Association of Memphis went into voluntary liquidation during the year and its stockholders were paid the book value of their stock and stock cancelled. The name of the German-American Association at Memphis was changed to the Home Building and Loan Association and the Home Building and Loan Association of Kingsport suspended operations and was directed to surrender its charter.

There are no foreign building and loan associations now authorized to transact business in Tennessee. The Legislature, in 1897, Chapter 26, sought to amend the building and loan law so as to include all foreign building and loan associations transacting business in Tennessee either under a building and loan plan or by the issuance of bonds, debentures, contracts or other form of investment, but the associations contested the law and it was declared unconstitutional in the case of the State ex rel Standard Trust Company of Delaware and Birmingham, Ala., v. State Treasurer, p. 776, 135 Southwestern Reporter, on account of defect in the title. No contracts have ever been issued by any of these foreign associations or investment companies coming under the observation of this department that could be recommended. Their operations have been disastrous to those conducting business with them and if permitted to transact any further business in Tennessee it should be only under stringent regulations of the building and loan department. The morals of such of these companies as have been trying to operate in Tennessee is not good and their financial condition unsound.

The restrictions placed by the Government on the construction of buildings has had no perceptible effect on the building and loan business. It has been suggested that the Building and Loan Law be amended so as to enable the associations to make loans on farm properties upon an annual basis. Should this appeal to your favorable consideration the business should be conducted in a most conservative manner in amounts not exceeding fifty per cent of the cash value of the land and not over twenty per cent of the cash value of the improvements and should be arranged so that no loan can run more than ten years. The stock issued on farm properties should be kept in a separate class from the other stock and no loans made except upon improved and well-tenanted farms.

The law should be amended so as to require all investment or other companies conducting business on plans similar to the building and loan plan as now understood to be placed under the supervision of this department in order that the public may be protected from further frauds in their operation and that they may be required to pay the same tax and obey the same laws local associations are governed by.

#### STATE DEBT.

The State Funding Board is composed of the Governor, Treasurer, Comptroller and Secretary of State.

The Funding Act, passed by the last Legislature on April 1, 1915, and approved by the Governor on April 3, 1915, authorized the State Funding Board to issue and sell the bonds of the State of Tennessee in such amount not exceeding thirteen million dollars (\$13,000,000.00) as would be needed for the purpose of paying the outstanding interest-bearing bonded indebtedness of the State. Issued under Chapter 51, Acts of 1913, and Senate Bill No. 960, 1915. Said indebtedness maturing July and October 1, 1915, and to fix the rate of interest not exceeding four and one-half per cent ( $4\frac{1}{2}\%$ ) per annum. The maturity of said bonds not to exceed forty years from their date.

The bonds to be redeemed amounted to eleven million seven hundred eighty-one thousand dollars (\$11,781,000.00); ten million three hundred eighty-one thousand dollars (\$10,381,-

000.00) maturing July 1, 1915, and one million four hundred thousand dollars (\$1,400,000.00) maturing October 1, 1915.

The Funding Board advertised the sale of eleven million, seven hundred eighty-one thousand dollars (\$11,781,000.00) State of Tennessee bonds to be dated July 1, 1915, and to bear interest at the rate of 4%, 4 $\frac{1}{4}$ %, or 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ %; no bonds to be sold at less than par. Bids were asked for on bonds maturing serially as shown by the following table, this report; all bids to be received and opened at the State Capitol, at noon, Thursday, May 6, 1915. All bids were opened accordingly and a syndicate composed of Messrs. Redmond & Co., Guaranty Trust Co. of New York; Kean, Taylor & Co.; Brown Bros. & Co.; Rhoades & Co., and White, Weld & Co., all of New York City, were the successful and best bidders. When the Funding Board sold to the above-named syndicate at par five million three hundred seventy thousand dollars (\$5,370,000.00) bonds bearing 4% interest per annum, and six million four hundred and eleven thousand dollars (\$6,411,000.00) bonds bearing interest at 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ % per annum.

Ten million three hundred eighty-one thousand dollars (\$10,381,000.00) of said bonds were delivered to the above-named syndicate on July 1, 1915, and one million four hundred thousand dollars (\$1,400,000.00) were delivered to them October 1, 1915; said syndicate paying the accrued interest on the \$1,400,000.00 bonds from July 1, 1915, to October 1, 1915, which amounted to fifteen thousand seven hundred and fifty dollars (\$15,750.00), said interest being placed in the Treasury of the State.

With the money realized from the sale of the above bonds the nine million three hundred and eighty-one thousand dollars (\$9,381,000.00) temporary loan refunding bonds, the one million dollars (\$1,000,000.00) short term notes, both maturing July 1, 1915, and the one million four hundred thousand dollars (\$1,400,000.00) temporary refunding bonds maturing October 1, 1915, were paid off; cancelled and posted in their proper books in the hands of the Secretary of the Funding Board.

The six hundred thousand dollars (\$600,000.00) penitentiary bonds, the one million dollars (\$1,000,000.00) redemption bonds,

which matured October 1, 1913, the nine million two hundred twenty-two thousand dollars (\$9,222,000.00) settlement bonds, which matured July 1, 1913, all of which were held in trust by the National Park Bank of New York, have been cancelled and posted in their proper books in the hands of the Secretary of the Funding Board.

The unfunded bonds outstanding, amounting to \$335,666.22, are held by the United States Government awaiting a settlement of claims between the State and Federal Government.

The State of Tennessee has claims against the Federal Government that will offset the amount of bonds the Government holds against the State.

An Act was passed by the Legislature of 1905 barring all bonds issued prior to July, 1883, if not presented for funding before January 1, 1907. The bonds held by the United States Government were exempt from the provisions of this Act.

In addition to the above, four hundred \$1,000 old bonds of the State of Tennessee are deposited in the Fourth National Bank of Nashville, Tenn., amounting to \$400,000.00. These bonds are made payable to the Louisville & Nashville Railroad Company. The Memphis, Clarksville & Louisville Railroad was sold under a foreclosure of mortgage by the State of Tennessee and was bought by the Louisville & Nashville Railroad; and the \$400,000.00 in bonds represent the last payment of the Louisville & Nashville Railroad on the purchase of the Memphis, Clarksville & Louisville Railroad. It appears that the Federal Government had a claim against the Memphis, Clarksville & Louisville Railroad, and these bonds were deposited in the Fourth National Bank of Nashville, Tenn., and are to be withdrawn only on the joint order of the commissioners and said company, and that they are to be held by said bank until the State can perfect a settlement with the United States.
